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# **BEDINVETMAB**

## **(Brand Name: Librela)**

**STRENGTH:** 5 mg, 10 mg, 15 mg, 20 mg  
and 30 mg injectable vials

**ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION:** Subcutaneous injection given by veterinary staff only.  
Should be administered once a month.

**ACTION OF MEDICATION:** Monoclonal antibody against nerve growth factor.

**MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED:** Injection site pain, increased water consumption possible. Possible increased risk for urinary tract infection.

**SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED:** Immune mediated life threatening reactions (anaphylaxis, immune mediated anemia, immune mediated platelet destruction) occur in less than 1 in 10,000 patients. Librela should not be used in patients with known neurologic disease.

**STORAGE:** N/A.

**IF YOU MISS A DOSE:** Simply make an appointment for a new dose.

**OTHER INFORMATION:** Should not be used in patients under one year of age, in nursing, pregnant or breeding patients as it is not appropriate to block nerve growth factors in these patients. Librela is best use as sole arthritis medication..
