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# MAROPITANT CITRATE

## (Brand Name: Cerenia)

**STRENGTH:** 16 mg, 24 mg, 60 mg, 160 mg Tablets

**ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION:** ORAL. May be given with or without food. Fasting is recommended when used for motion sickness. In this situation, medication should be given 2 hours before travel.

**ACTION OF MEDICATION:** NK-1 Receptor blocker, Primarily an anti-nauseal but also had anti-inflammatory and pain relieving properties.

**MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED:** Occasionally a dog will vomit the pill immediately. This is mitigated by giving the pill with a small amount of food..

**SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED:** The FDA has received sporadic reports of more serious reactions: facial swelling, incoordination, fever, muscle tremors, and convulsions.

**STORAGE:** Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

**IF YOU MISS A DOSE:** Simply give the forgotten dose when it is remembered and time the next dose accordingly. This is typically a once daily medication.

**OTHER INFORMATION:** There is some potential for interactions with other medications. Be sure your veterinarian is aware of all supplements and medications your pet is taking.
