



(BRAND NAME: Onsior)

STRENGTH: 6 mg, 10 mg, 20 mg, 40 mg tablets

ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: ORAL

May be given with or without food.

ACTION OF MEDICATION: Cox-2 Selective Non-steroidal Anti-inflammatory Drug (used for pain especially from inflammatory conditions). This medication is able to concentrate at the site of inflammation which other anti-inflammatory medications are not able to do.

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Mild diarrhea, appetite loss, vomiting.

SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Problems occur mostly with pre-existing liver or kidney disease which can be made worse with use of this medication. Monitoring tests are recommended with long term use. Other severe side effects include stomach ulceration and inappropriate bleeding. These side effects are very rare. Drug interactions may make these side effects more likely (see link below).

STORAGE: Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

IF YOU MISS A DOSE: Do not double up on the next dose. Simply give the medication when it is remembered or pick up with the next dose, allowing at least the proper interval between doses according to the label instructions.

OTHER INFORMATION: When giving pills to a cat, it is a good idea to chase the pill with a small syringe of water to wash it down. Approved for pets over 5.5 lbs in size and over 4 months in age. Can be used in both dogs and cats. NOT COMPATIBLE WITH STEROID MEDICATIONS NOR WITH OTHER NSAIDS.
