TERBINAFINE (Brand Name: Lamasil)

STRENGTH: 250 mg Tablets, also Topical ointment.

ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION: ORAL. May be given with or without food.

ACTION OF MEDICATION: Interferes with the structure of the fungal cell wall. Used against many fungal diseases especially ringworm.

MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Vomiting (which can be mitigated by giving the medication with food), also diarrhea, reduced appetite.

SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS REPORTED: Metabolized through the liver. Has potential to make pre-existing liver disease worse. Kidney disease is also considered a risk factor with terbinafine usage. Bone marrow suppression has been reported.

STORAGE: Keep away from light and store at room temperature. Do not refrigerate.

IF YOU MISS A DOSE: Do not double up on the next dose. Simply give the medication when it is remembered or pick up with the next dose, allowing at least the proper interval between doses according to the label instructions.

OTHER INFORMATION: Potential for many drug interactions. Be sure your veterinarian knows all medications your pet uses.
